MINUTES of a meeting of Antony/Wilcove Parish Council held on Tuesday 28th October 2014 at 7.30pm in the Village Hall, Wilcove, Cornwall.

51-14 - Apologies for Absence

Apologies for absence were submitted on behalf of Police Sgt A Crowe.

52-14 – Declarations of Interest relating to items on the Agenda

53-14 – Thanckes Oil Fuel Depot Update – Powerpoint presentation by Nigel Horwell and James Prescott of Hyder Consulting PLC

Mr J Prescott gave a powerpoint presentation to Councillors updating them on the latest plan for the proposed new jetty extension at Thanckes Oil Fuel Depot. Mr N Horwell answered any questions raised by Councillors who were in favour of the new jetty as no objections were raised. The plans are available to view on-line. The Clerk will write thanking Nigel Horwell and James Prescott for attending the meeting and up-dating Councillors.

54-14 – Police Report

In the absence of a police representative the Clerk informed the Council that there were no incidents to report within the Antony/Wilcove Parish. Police Sergeant A Crowe informed the Clerk that the Speedwatch training commenced during October 2014.

55-14 – Bonfire and Fireworks Display/Wilcove Inn

It has been brought to the attention of the Parish Council that the Wilcove Inn is to hold a bonfire and fireworks event on the 8th November 2014 and in the interests of public safety the Clerk will write to the Landlord of the Wilcove Inn requesting that all necessary permission, risk assessments and insurances are in place.

56-14 – Minutes of the Previous Meeting

57-14 – Matters Arising from the Minutes

a) Pursuant to minute 45-14(g) – Councillor R Carter reported that he had attempted to discover further information about the ‘Ring O’ Bells’ pub in Antony but could establish nothing new.

b) Pursuant to minute 45-14(b) – Councillor G Shepherd produced a quotation for the proposed new sign to be placed at the entrance to Wilcove Village. The Clerk will forward this information to Cornwall Council for approval.

- c) Pursuant to minute 50-14(a) – The Clerk reported that she had spoken to Cornwall Council about the possibility of purchasing a dog waste bin and was informed that the Council does not provide dog waste bins and the Parish Council would have to purchase their own bin and enter into a private agreement with Cory to have the bin emptied. Various other options were discussed and the Parish council voted no to purchasing a bin.
- d) The Clerk reported that after speaking to Scott Sharples of Cornwall Council regarding the possibility of taking over the running of the Tregantle car park, she had been informed that Cornwall Council have identified the car park as a potential to generate income. The Parish Council would still like to register it's interest and look at other services that could be taken on within the Parish. The Clerk will contact Esther Richmond to discuss further.
- e) Councillor W A Lobb informed Councillors that a 20ft fibreglass boat has been fly tipped at Wacker Quay. The Clerk will inform Cornwall Council to have the boat removed.
