Mr Ryan representing The Peninsula Trust outlined a proposal to take over the Tregantle Car Park and develop it with a café/ surf shop and work units. This would be a 3 year project. Their aim would be to allow users to park free, therefore negating the need for drivers to park on Military Road.

Mr Rideout explained that as a result of the Land stewardship scheme, farming practices on the estate had been restricted, which he agreed has lead to more runoff from the fields. Currently Antony Estates are restricted from finding old drainage channels that could alleviate this problems.

Mr Rideout explained that the long term plan was to move Antony Farm from the village and then utilise the land for economic benefit for the Estate.
