"Antony PC Meeting report – 25th January 2022

Kate Ewert – Cornwall Councillor for Rame Peninsula & St Germans

<u>Antony Specific</u>

- My Millbrook Surgery continues to be well attended with residents attending from across my divisional area I am seeing a growing number of residents contacting me about evictions where properties are being turned to AirBBs.
- I have forwarded on a number of reports of breaches of covenants to ex-RTB properties within the division. These are being investigated and the officers responsible are working with the property owners to stop the issue.
- The MSAS unit that was in situ in Antony has just been reported the basic data is 85th percentile speeds 33mph. Average speeds 27.17mph. I was pleasantly surprised by this as I had expected a much higher average speed.
- The new Highways Scheme has just been announced, this year's allocation is for approx. £55k for the Cornwall Gateway Area. We have a very tight turn around to get EOI registered in time for the March deadline. They need to be deliverable for this coming financial year. I have called a meeting of the Rame Cluster for the 1st Feb to discuss this in more detail.
- The Leisure Centre in Saltash has been given a reprieve for at least 2 years. With the other Cornwall Councillors from the Saltash area we have established a working group to see how we can best support the centre going forward to ensure its success. It is by no means certain that its future is safe, but there is at least a good cross party group attempting to make it a success.
- I have joined the working group on Torpoint TC working on the results of a feasibility study for a swimming pool and leisure centre in the town.
- Cornwall Council is in full budget setting (and cutting) mode at the moment, and all our scrutiny committees are scrutinising the budget proposals. It isn't a happy situation I hate to report. The Childrens and Families Oversight and Scrutiny committee I am on, voted to recommend the budget with a £5.2m cut to childrens services we proposed an amendment but it was voted down. "

It was proposed that Antony Parish Council request a one way system for Antony School. **Action:** Cllr Bulmer to submit an application.

1 Pengelly Close debris and tyre still remain, waiting action by Cornwall Housing. 1 Yonderbury cottage, also has debris awaiting collection. **Action:** Cllr Ewert to pursue.
